

Baker County Virtual Classroom Application for Enrollment

Please review the eligibility criteria below, complete the application, and submit it to the front office of the school your child would normally attend for the 2020 – 2021 school year. To meet the needs of all of our virtual students, this application must be submitted to the front office of your child's school by Friday, July 31.

Eligibility Criteria

The following are eligibility requirements for enrollment in the Baker County Virtual Classroom.

Residency Requirements

• The student must be a resident of Baker County, Florida

Age Requirements

- Students enrolling in Kindergarten must be 5 years old on or before September 1 for the 2020 2021 school year.
- Students enrolling in first grade must be 6 years old on or before September 1 for the 2020 2021 school year.

Requirements for Students with Disabilities

- Students with disabilities are required to meet the admission criteria to be accepted into the Baker County Virtual Classroom, just as their non-disabled peers.
- Current Individual Educational Plans (IEP) of student applicants who meet the school's entrance criteria
 will be reviewed on an individual basis in order to determine the appropriateness of the virtual
 education option.

Attendance Policy

- Students are expected to be logged on and actively participating during the designated class times. This includes sharing their video image throughout the instructional process.
- Failure to meet this attendance requirement, will result in the student being marked as absent.
- The School District attendance policies will also apply to Virtual Classroom students.
- Pending Florida Department of Education guidance, students may be required to participate on campus for progress monitoring and state mandated assessments, such as the Florida Standards Assessments and End-of-Course (EOC) exams.

Guidelines for Participation

- Students are expected to follow the District's Student Code of Conduct.
- <u>Capturing screen images or recording audio/video of other students or teachers is strictly prohibited.</u>
 Students are expected to follow the same behavioral guidelines as on-campus school students.
- Virtual Classroom students are participants in the classroom environment. As such, all students are expected to respect the rights and privacy of other participants in the learning process.

Technology Requirements

- To maintain contact with teachers, staff, and administration, students must have daily access during school hours to the following:
 - *Computer with Internet access
 - Internet service
 - Telephone
