Sponsored by Rack Up Thrift Store
Open to all BCHS Seniors with a minimum of 300 Community Service Hours

 - 2) **Baker County Education Support Professionals (BCESP) Scholarship** – Open to all BCHS Seniors with a minimum of 2.5 GPA, priority given to a BCESP Association member – **4 @ \$400**

 - 3) **Baker County Retired Educators Scholarship** – Open to all BCHS Seniors – **1 @ \$250**

 - 4) **BCEF “Leaving a Legacy” Scholarship** – Preference given to student with 3.0 GPA pursuing career in Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math **1 @ \$4,000 (\$1,000 per year for 4 years)**

If no applicant meets the family descendant criteria, the scholarship may be awarded to a BCHS graduate on the basis of high academic achievement.

BCHS AFJROTC Senior with minimum of 2.0 GPA, 20 Hours of Community Service, Preference given to financially disadvantaged student, Possesses a positive attitude toward the military, Excels in all military and scholastic aspects at the time of election and presentation of the award, Indicates by military and scholastic grades, extracurricular activities, and individual endeavors a desire to serve our nation, Demonstrates outstanding quality in leadership, discipline, character, compassion, and citizenship, and Is enrolling in an accredited institution of higher learning.

30)Ray & Athena Brown Memorial Scholarship - BCHS Senior **attending Florida Gateway College** with at least a 2.5 GPA - **1 @ \$900 (sponsored by The Foundation for Florida Gateway College)**

31)Teacher Cadet Scholarship – BCHS Seniors **attending Florida Gateway College** and enrolled in the Teacher Cadet Program **1 @ \$4,500**

BCHS Senior with minimum of 2.5 GPA, 75 Volunteer or Community Service Hours, Must be direct descendant of Taylor School Alumni (Taylor High School/Taylor Elementary School), Must provide a letter of request to include: [a. Explain your family relationship to Taylor School Alumni, Explain your need for the Scholarship, and Explain your future educational plans] Provide 2 verifications of attendance by the Taylor School Alumni (examples include: Report Cards, Diplomas, Certificates of Attendance, School Pictures, Yearbook Pictures from the school yearbook: Memories – Taylor School Days- (1938-1968), Graduate Rosters from: Baker County In Review – Baker County- Wide Homecoming (April 16-19, 1987), Certificates of Completion, Awards, Certificates of Recognition, etc.) and 2 Character Reference Letters
