

# BAKER COUNTY PRIOR GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

Listed below are the scholarships that are available through the Baker County Education Foundation. These scholarships are available for individuals who have graduated from Baker County High School and currently reside in Baker County. The deadline for applying for a scholarship is Wednesday, April 10, 2019. Applications are available on the district website at [www.bakerk12.org](http://www.bakerk12.org).

1) **The Baker County Community Service Scholarship – 2 @ \$1,000**  
**Sponsored by Rack Up Thrift Store**

Attend college or some other post-secondary training institution, must have graduated from Baker County High School, 50 community service hours, priority given to economically disadvantaged, and applicant must provide proof of enrollment at a college or post-secondary institution

2) **The BCHS Class of 1958 Scholarship – 1 @ \$400**

BCHS Graduate, hold a high school diploma or GED diploma, established long term residency in Baker County, will return and contribute to the citizens of Baker County, must demonstrate financial need, and intent of receiving either vocational or academic training for developing employable work skills

3) **The Emily, Kelli & Kristie Moore Scholarship – 1 @ \$500**

Attend college, must have graduated from Baker County High School, pursuing major in education or in the medical field, preference given to financially disadvantaged student, and must provide proof of enrollment at a college or university

---

4) **The Neil & Beatrice Kirkland Scholarship – 1 @ \$500**

Going to college or to some other post-secondary training institution, must be a resident of Baker County, must have graduated from Baker County High School, or have a GED diploma from Baker County and must have been graduated for at least three years prior to application date, must demonstrate financial need, must complete 24 semester hours or the equivalent within 24 months of receiving this scholarship, training or studies must be in a field that leads to employment in that area or specialty, must demonstrate a personal commitment to the completion of the program of study or training, must show how this training will benefit the general wellbeing of Baker County

5) **The Norma G. Kirkland Scholarship** – 1 @ \$500

Going to college or to some other post-secondary training institution, must be a resident of Baker County, must have graduated from Baker County High School, or have a GED diploma from Baker County and must have been graduated for at least three years prior to application date, must demonstrate financial need, must complete 24 semester hours or the equivalent within 24 months of receiving this scholarship, training or studies must be in a field that leads to employment in that area or specialty, must demonstrate a personal commitment to the completion of the program of study or training, must show how this training will benefit the general wellbeing of Baker County
