The recommendation includes that Baker County High School student case #011620183451573 is not eligible for the early re-entry program. Upon returning to the Baker County Public Schools, Baker County High School student case #011620183451573 must re-enter through the Baker County High School alternative school setting for a minimum of forty-five (45) days. As recommended by Superintendent Raulerson, Dean Griffis made a motion to approve, seconded by Artie Burnett. The motion carried 5-0.
