The Baker County School Board met on Tuesday, January 22, 2013, at 5:00 p.m. in the District School Board Room for a closed expulsion review hearing on **Baker County High School student case #071620124453844**. The following Board Members were present to wit: Chairperson Richard “Dean” Griffis, Vice-Chairperson Patricia C. Weeks, Charlie M. Burnett, III (Artie), and Jesse D. Davis. Board Member Earl “Dwight” Crews was not present for the closed expulsion review hearing. Superintendent Sherrie Raulerson and School Board Attorney Jonathan Oliff were both in attendance. The student and the student’s father were both in attendance at the hearing.

Chairperson Griffis called the closed expulsion review hearing on **Baker County High School student case #071620124453844** to order and turned the proceedings over to Superintendent Raulerson. After hearing the evidence and testimonies presented, Superintendent Raulerson made the recommendation to allow **Baker County High School student case #071620124453844** early re-entry into the Baker County Public Schools. The recommendation includes that **Baker County High School student case #071620124453844** must re-enter through the Alternative School setting at Baker County High School for a minimum of forty-five days. As recommended by Superintendent Raulerson, Jesse Davis made a motion to approve, seconded by Artie Burnett. The motion carried 4-0.

The Baker County School Board met on Tuesday, January 22, 2013, at 6:30 p.m. in the Sanderson Congregational Holiness Church. The purpose of this meeting was to hold the regular Board Meeting and recognize the “Academic Achievers” from the Sanderson community. Chairperson Griffis introduced Pastor Oral Lyons who gave the invocation. Then, he introduced Lily Kate and Billy Elledge, children of Will and Allison Elledge, who led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Robin Mobley, Associate Superintendent, stated that Baker County High School logged 845 volunteers for a total of 2,134 volunteer hours. Mrs. Mobley and Superintendent Raulerson presented Principal Tom Hill with their Golden and Silver Awards.

- **Recognize School Volunteer Award** (*Baker County Middle School - Golden 30 Years Award*) Robin Mobley (259-0427)

Robin Mobley, Associate Superintendent, stated that Baker County Middle School logged 412 volunteers for a total of 2,919 volunteer hours. Mrs. Mobley and Superintendent Raulerson presented Assistant Principal Allen Murphy with their 30 Year Golden Award.

- **Recognize School Volunteer Awards** (*Golden Awards - Baker County Pre-K/Kindergarten Center, Macclenny Elementary School, Westside Elementary School, Keller Intermediate School*) Robin Mobley (259-0427)

Robin Mobley, Associate Superintendent, stated that Baker County Pre-K/Kindergarten Center logged 816 volunteers for a total of 2,134 volunteer hours, Macclenny Elementary School logged 1,590 volunteers for a total of 4,863 volunteer hours, Westside Elementary School logged 99 volunteers for a total of 4,604 volunteer hours, and Keller Intermediate School logged 235 volunteers for a total of 2,703 volunteer hours.
