The recommendation includes that **Baker County High School student case #072020154001135R** must re-enter through the Baker County High School alternative school setting for a minimum of forty-five (45) days unless an earlier release date is deemed appropriate by the Baker County High School administration. As recommended by Superintendent Raulerson, Artie Burnett made a motion to approve, seconded by Patricia Weeks. The motion carried 5-0.
