Upon returning to the Baker County Public Schools, **Baker County Middle School student** case #030220155001694 must re-enter through the alternative school setting at Baker County Middle School for a minimum of forty-five days. As recommended by Superintendent Raulerson, Artie Burnett made a motion to approve, seconded by Dean Griffis. The motion carried 5-0.
