The Baker County School Board met on Monday, May 7, 2012, at 4:30 p.m. in the District School Board Room located at 270 South Boulevard East, Macclenny, Florida. The purpose of this meeting was to hold a closed expulsion hearing on **Baker County Middle School student case #050720124305233**. The following Board Members were present to wit: Chairperson Richard “Dean” Griffis, Vice-Chairperson Patricia C. Weeks, Charlie M. Burnett, III (Artie), and Earl “Dwight” Crews. Board Member Jesse D. Davis was not present at the hearing. The student and the student’s mother were both in attendance at the hearing.

Chairperson Griffis called the closed expulsion hearing to order and then turned the proceedings over to Superintendent Raulerson. After hearing the evidence and testimonies presented, Superintendent Raulerson made the recommendation to expel **Baker County Middle School student case #050720124305233** from the Baker County Public Schools for the remainder of the 2011-2012 school year and all of the 2012-2013 school year, which includes the Adult Education Program. The recommendation includes that **Baker County Middle School student case #050720124305233 is not eligible** for the early re-entry program. Upon returning to the Baker County Public Schools, **Baker County Middle School student case #050720124305233** must re-enter through the alternative school setting at Baker County Middle School for a minimum of forty-five (45) days. As recommended by Superintendent Raulerson, Patricia Weeks made a motion to approve, seconded by Artie Burnett. The motion carried 4-0.
