Macclenny Elementary & Westside Elementary

- Both schools scored higher than the state averages in Grade 3 ELA and Grade 3 Math
- Ranked 2nd in the state in Grade 3 ELA
- Ranked 3rd in the state in Grade 3 Math

Keller Intermediate School

- Increased percentage of students scoring proficient in Grade 4 ELA
- Scored higher than the state average in Grade 5 Math

Baker County Middle School

- Increased percentage of students scoring proficient in six areas (Grade 6 ELA, Grade 7 ELA, Grade 8 ELA, Grade 6 Math, Grade 7 Math, and Civics EOC)

- Scored higher than the state averages in five areas (Grade 6 ELA, Grade 6 Math, Grade 7 Math, Grade 8 Science, and Civics EOC)
- Ranked in the top 10 in the state in three areas (Civics – ranked 7th, Grade 6 ELA – ranked 7th, and Grade 6 Math – ranked 9th)

Baker County High School

- Increased percentage of students scoring proficient in Grade 9 ELA
