The Baker County School Board met on Monday, July 27, 2015, at 5:00 p.m., in the District School Board Room located at 270 South Boulevard East, Macclenny, Florida. The purpose of this meeting was to hold the regular Board business meeting and public hearing.

Chairperson Weeks announced that Johnnie Jacobs was going to give the invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Bonnie Jones.
