

# Parental Exemption Request

HB-545 gives parents the right to request their student be exempt from reproductive health and disease education. Pursuant to s. 1002.20, F.S.; A public school student whose parent makes written request to the school principal shall be exempted from the teaching of reproductive health or any disease, including HIV/AIDS, in accordance with the provisions of s. 1003.42(3). After you have reviewed the course lesson content and you wish to submit a request for exemption, please complete the request for exemption and submit it to the principal of the school.
