JOB DESCRIPTION

**AEROSPACE SCIENCE AND LEADERSHIP INSTRUCTOR**

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

- (1) Must possess a high school diploma or equivalent and may be required to complete appropriate course work to meet requirements of state certification, depending upon state or school requirements.
- (2) Must be a retired Air Force noncommissioned officer (staff sergeant through chief master sergeant) with a minimum of 15 years of extended active duty and retired 5 years or less when hired as an instructor (may be waived if the applicant is otherwise exceptionally well qualified).
- (3) Must have completed the ASIC for AFOATS certification. Certification is valid for 3 years, at which time the instructor must be recertified by accomplishing one of the recertification options available.
- (4) Must possess self-direction, initiative, self-reliance. Instructors should be dynamic and have an understanding of the physical, intellectual, social, and emotional growth patterns of high school students.
- (5) Must be of good moral character and have an enthusiasm for aerospace science, teaching and the Air Force.

**KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:**

Knowledge of audiovisual presentation methods, curriculum planning, Air Force educational programs, drill and ceremonies, and educational administration, including tests and measurements.

- (4) Other duties as directed by the Senior Aerospace Science and Leadership Instructor.

**PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Medium Work: Exerting up to 50 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 20 pounds of force frequently as needed to move objects.
